I became a Christian at the age of nine when my family began going to a small First Baptist church. Unfortunately, I didn't know what being a Christian even meant and it didn't take long for me to feel like I didn't belong or fit in there. So at the age of 18 I was all too happy not to have to go anymore.

Though I enjoyed Southlake, I realized that I didn't know anything about a Christian life. Even the basics like why did people say God sometimes and Jesus other times. I had no clue. Shortly there after, an insert was included in the weekly bulletin regarding Alpha . I knew this is what I needed.

The first evening was quite uncomfortable for me when I realized that small groups were involved. Keep in mind that I was still at a point of being very ashamed of who I had become and I was sure that everyone would know, just by looking at me, how miserable I was feeling inside. Very luckily I found the courage to go back the next week.

Alpha has helped change my life. I have a new understanding now of who God is and why he sent Jesus to earth. I know the indescribable sacrifice Jesus made for me by dying on that cross. I know without a doubt that my past is forgiven and I know and feel the incredible love that my Father in heaven has for me. I have begun reading the bible for the first time in

my life and understand it. As far as my scary small group....well today I consider them my brothers and sisters in Christ whom I love very much. Friendships that will last forever.

Alpha has been a powerful experience in my life. The personal relationship I have with God today is a blessing that I know I will never be worthy of. I know that whatever life throws my way I will be able to walk through it because I am never alone. I realize that words can't begin to describe how grateful and joyous I feel in the confidence that I am walking, for the first time, down the path that God has laid down for my life.
